Jason McDonald enjoyed a successful career in Sydney as an award-winning graphic designer before returning to the family farm near Mudgee NSW where he grew up surrounded by nature. It was here in 2015, Jason established his luxury accommodation - Permanent Camping Eco Retreat - while also following new directions in his creative pursuits.

Jason began a love of photographing landscapes, birds, insects, flora and fauna and then turning his photography into works of photo media art. In 2018, Jason featured in his first exhibition in Mudgee and since then has appeared in many national group shows.
