Terrain – The Corner Store Gallery April 12 - 23

Ann is a Sydney based contemporary landscape artist who paints directly from the landscape, either on canvas or in a journal. She captures the essence of the landscape with automatic drawing and mixed media techniques using handmade brushes collected from the surrounding bush. Her intuitive, energetic and layered artworks capture the energy of the natural environment.

In this group exhibition, Terrain, Ann celebrates the magic moment each Autumn when the colour peaks on the poplar trees between Oberon and Bathurst. When the sun sets it casts pink shadows over the grasslands of O'Connell. "It's a special time of year to walk the fields and let the terrain 'tell the story of the season'"

Ann's work has been selected as a finalist in several art prizes including The Fishers Ghost, Gosford Art Prize and the Waverley Landscape Prize. She holds a Bachelor of Design Hons (Visual Communications), University of Technology.
